"Malala Yousafzai (born July 12, 1997[1]) is a Pakistani student and education activist. She is known for her activism for girls' and women's rights, especially for her campaign to allow girls to go to school. She was a victim of a gunshot attack in October 2012.[2]

Yousafzai is the youngest person to have won the Nobel Peace Prize. She was awarded the prize in October 2014, when she was just 17 years old.[3] She was nominated for the prize the year before that.[4]

Besides the Nobel Prize in 2014, Yousafzai has been honoured for her work many times."
